The last day indigo print workshop "AIZOME" ~藍染~





On the last day we had a chance to visit an indigo print workshop, and become part of making-your-own-indigo-dye-piece-of-fabric experience. We learned extensively about Japanese indigo dyeing called "aizome" that goes back to ancient times. The characteristic blue of the dye come from the leaves of the Japanese indigo plant, thus is sometimes called "Japan blue".



We were able to follow the whole process using traditional dyeing method with no chemicals: first, the item is watered, then the parts of cloth you want to leave white tied with rubber bands (or even beans), and rub well in an indigo dye vat. After removing

the rubber bands and wash the piece, you can see the "Japan blue" and nice unique pattern

The educational experience of creating your own piece using this technique was fascinating. It makes you appreciate the old methods of creating fashion clothes, authentic craftsmanship and beauty of hand-work. Although the method is very old, it still has deep influence on contemporary fashion. The outcome – a tie-dye T-Shirt – was really beautiful with a deep blue colour as a result of multiple soaking in dye vat.
